Is your local fire department acquainted with your facilities?							
If you have a fire alarm system, is it certified as required?							
If you have a fire alarm, is it tested at least annually?							
Are fire doors and shutters in good operating condition?							
Are fire doors unobstructed and protected against obstructions?							
Are fire door fusible links in place?							
WALKWAYS							
Are aisles and passageways kept clear?							
Are changes of direction or elevations readily identifiable?							
EXIT/EGRESS							
Are all exits marked with signs and illuminated lights?							
Are directions to exits, which are not easily visible, marked with signs?							
Are doors or stairs that are not exits clearly marked "NOT AN EXIT"?							
Are EXIT sign letters at least 5 inches high and ½ inch wide?							
Are exit doors free of obstructions?							
Are there at least two exits available in all work areas?							
Are exits adequate in number for the occupancy load in case of an emergency?

Are exit/egress landings properly illuminated?				
Are emergency lights provided and inspected/tested regularly and documented?				
Do all exits operate during a power failure?				
Are exit doors checked regularly for blockage from outside?				
EXIT DOORS				
Are exit doors operable from direction of egress without a key or any special knowledge of effort?				
Are sliding, revolving or overhead doors prohibited as exits?				
Where panic hardware is required, will the door open with 15 lbs. or less of force?				
Are cold storage room doors provided with inside release mechanisms?				
Barriers provided on landings where doors open to alleys, streets or elevated platforms to prevent being hit by vehicles or falling objects when exiting the building?
